National bodies that submitted comments are listed below in alphabetical order.

Two National Bodies voted Negatively on the DIS. A resolution of the comments of those National Bodies is provided here.

### Israel (yes)

Accepted in principle. The following text is proposed to appear in Annex A:

According to the Romanian Standards Institute, the letters LATIN CAPITAL LETTER S WITH COMMA BELOW, LATIN SMALL LETTER S WITH COMMA BELOW, LATIN CAPITAL LETTER T WITH COMMA BELOW, and LATIN SMALL LETTER T WITH COMMA BELOW in use in Romania, are different from the corresponding letters LATIN CAPITAL LETTER S WITH CEDILLA, LATIN SMALL LETTER S WITH CEDILLA, LATIN CAPITAL LETTER T WITH CEDILLA, and LATIN SMALL LETTER T WITH CEDILLA that are specified in part 2 of ISO/IEC 8859. However, subject to the agreement of originator and receiver in information interchange the letters WITH CEDILLA in part 2 may be used to substitute for the letters WITH COMMA BELOW.

I believe this satisfies the Israeli comment.

### Japan (no):

Technical comment. Accepted. The error has been corrected. Editorial comments. Accepted.

I believe this satisfies the Japanese comment.

#### Sweden (yes)

- 1. Accepted. ISO-IR 199 has been assigned to the character set and clause 7 appropriately updated.
- 2. Accepted in principle. Annex A in parts 1-10 of this standard does not refer to parts above part 10. Annex A for part 14 should refer to itself and to the previous parts. In any case the agenda is informative.

I believe this satisfies the Swedish comment.

#### **United States: (no)**

Not accepted. The U.S. objections to the creation of new 8-bit standards have been noted. This part of 8859 has been approved by SC2, as it meets current user needs.

I do not believe this satisfies the U.S. comment.
