WG2 COMMENTS ON DRAFT PASCAL BINDING FOR LIPC

(1) Since ISO 7185 does not provide for separate compilation (although most Pascal implementations provide it as an extension), WG2 questions the utility of an LIPC-Pascal Binding, and whether provision of this Binding would be sufficient to resolve the UK NO-vote.

- (2) In 7.2 & 7.3, insert hyphens in "implementation-defined".
- (3) In 7.5, replace "integer-type" by "integer", and "real-type" by "real". It would probably be best to use bold or some other distinguished font for "integer", "real", "array of char".
