# 5. Work Item 22.16 - Language Independent Procedure Calling

Since the last meeting an informative annex has been drafted on the LIPC IDN - RPC IDL alignment issue. The document (WG11/N399R) was subsequently sent to SC22 for information (SC22/N1831) and ITTF for DIS ballot. The ballot will close on September 18, just in time for the next meeting.
