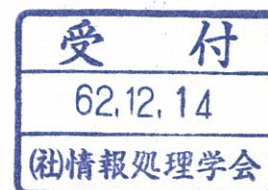

ISO TC97 SPECIAL GROUP ON FUNCTIONAL STANDARDIZATION

Resolutions of the second meeting of the ISO/TC97 Special Group on Functional Standardization, held on September 16-18, 1987 in London, England.

RESOLUTION 1 (APPROVED)

1. That the second sentence in the first bullet under section 3.1 of N1911 be edited to read as

This will include a review of the identified purpose for the ISP and identify liaisons required with committees responsible for the base standards called up in the ISP.

RESOLUTION 2 (APPROVED)

2. That TC97/SG-FS requests TC97 to ensure that in the allocation of responsibilities and authorities for the committee structure reporting to JTC1, ~~the~~ the successor to TC97/SG-FS be allocated at least the following powers.

- a) Those rights and responsibilities as defined for a subcommittee (SC) in the ISO Directives.
- b) The right to negotiate with the ISO/CS for a new form of publication for the taxonomy of International Standardized Profiles, to be published on a probable frequency of twice per year.

TC97/SG-FS requests the concurrence of TC97 on this request so that the work may proceed expeditiously and effectively.

RESOLUTION 3 (APPROVED)

Directed to: ISO-CS for onward circulation to all appropriate ISO Technical Committees.

3. TC97/SG-FS has identified that Technical Committees other than TC97

are working in the field of Information Technology and may wish to develop functional standards (i.e., ISPs). TC97/SG-FS wishes to draw the attention of the ISO/CS to the need to ensure the maximum degree of co-ordination within ISO by means of some centralized approach.

As an interim pragmatic measure to satisfy immediate requirements, TC97/SG-FS invites other Technical Committees to

participate in the TC97 functional standardization activity by means of liaison membership of TC97/SG-FS. Liaison membership enables other Technical Committees with immediate requirements for functional standards in the field of information technology to propose ISPs for inclusion in the current TC97/SG-FS work.

RESOLUTION 4.
