C. Future processing of Parts 1, 3 and 4 of PDTR 10000

The SG-FS approves the following procedure and schedule fo the future  
processing of part 1, 3 and 4 of PDTR 10000 and empowers the editors  
and convers accordingly:

end June 1988 : editors distribute revised drafts to individual  
participants at the Tokyo 1988 SG-FS and FSTG meetings,  
with A request for comments of accuracy to be returned  
to the editors by August 1st, 1988



mid August 1988 : editors distribute subsequently revised drafts to individual participants at the Tokyo SG-FS and FSTG meetings

on or before 16 September 1988 : SG-FS P-members indicate to the SG-FS convener and secretariat whether or not further processing of these parts at DTR level is acceptable

on or before 1 October 1988 : Parts 1, 3 and 4 are sent out for 3-months ballot. If no P-members have objected to processing at DTR level within JTC 1; if one or more P-members have objected to DTR processing, this ballot B at 2nd PDTR level within SG-FS.
