The National Body of Japan and Korea have agreed as below.

- (1) JTC 1 appoints JISC as the Secretariat of the JTC 1/SC 34.
- (2) When the resignation of the current chair, Dr. James David Mason, is announced, JISC will nominate the person who is recommended by the Korean National Body, KATS, as a new chair of the JTC 1/SC 34.

The process hereafter should follow the JTC 1 Directives. In other words, the JTC 1/SC 34 approves the new chair, then JTC 1 appoints the new chair of JTC 1/SC 34 at its plenary meeting.
