SGFS acknowledges the receipt of the contribution on AOM2x taxonomy, which has been accepted by SGFS during this meeting and has been added to the new edition of TR10000-2, to be sent out for ballot after the meeting.

SGFS also discussed the other contribution coming from the NM SIGs/EG, dealing with the use in letters in taxonomy identifiers. SGFS agreed that this could be possible, and made the corresponding change in TR10000-2 to be sent out for ballot. There is however an editor's note which points out to this and raises the question of whether this change should apply to all taxonomy identifiers or should be restricted to Network Management. It may be that editorial modifications are needed in TR10000-2, because abc are used as examples of digits which are used in taxonomy identifiers. Also, letters (x,y,z) are currently used in the AOM taxonomy principles so this may need to be reviewed.
