- Issue 2 Protocol profile testing methodology
  - Current status: waiting for the update of TR 10000-2 to include normative reference to ISO/IEC 9464.
    - Discussion: TR 10000-2:1994 contains normative references to ISO/IEC 9646-6:1994 and ISO/IEC 9646-7:1994.

Proposal: Close the issue.

- Issue 4 Conformance
  - Current status: waiting for the update of TR 10000-2 to include normative reference to ISO/IEC 9464.

Discussion: TR 10000-2:1994 contains normative references to ISO/IEC 9646-6:1994 and ISO/IEC 9646-7:1994.

Proposal: Close the issue.

- Issue 10 PICS Proforma instructions and Annex C of TR 10000-1
  - Current status: waiting for the update of TR 10000-2 to include normative reference to ISO/IEC 9464. When this is done, Annex C can be removed from TR 10000-1.
  - Discussion: TR 10000-2:1994 contains normative references to ISO/IEC 9646-6:1994 and ISO/IEC 9646-7:1994, Annex C of TR 10000-1 is removed.

Proposal: Close the issue.

Issue 12 Profile qualifiers and orthogonal functions

Current status: The issue was related to taxonomy for Managed Objects.

Discussion: The US proposals for the MO taxonomy issue in TR 10000-2 were accepted.

Proposal: The issue seem to have faded away, so close the issue.

- Issue 15 Terminology: a choice between AEP and OSE
  - Current status: this issue was open pending the discussions on the scope, methodology and terminology related to the expansion of the scope of TR 10000 from OSI to OSE.
  - Discussion: with the agreement rached in Cannes and the production of the latest drafts of TR 10000-1.3 (SGFS/N1178) and TR 10000-3 (SGFS/N1181) this issue can be considered to be resolved.

Proposal: Close the issue.

Issue 19 Taxonomy

- Current status: this issue was open pending the discussions on the scope, methodology and terminology related to the expansion of the scope of TR 10000 from OSI to OSE.
- Discussion: the OSE taxonomy in TR 10000-3 is minimal, and will be changed based on proposals from submitters of ISPs. There is no pre-concieved overall OSE taxonomy.

Proposal: Close the issue.

- Issue 21 Conformance testing of OSE
  - Current status: Open, pending contributions. New contributions:
    - N982 UK position on ODP conformance testing
    - N1004 Liaison statement to SC21/WG1 and SC22/WG15 on Conformance
    - N1132 SC22/WG15 Liaison statement on Harmonizing conformance
  - Discussion: The OSI conformance is now covered by ISO/IEC 9646, the conformance to APIs shall be based on DIS 13210.

Proposal: Further study is necessary, issue should remain open.

- Issue 28 Profile Versions and ISP Revisions
  - Discussion: Although the proposed text of SGFS/N764 is in principle incorporated in TR 10000-1.3, the issue as described in SGFS/N698 still seems to exist. New example: the old and new Directory ISPs.

Proposal: Keep open, for discussion in New Orleans.

Issue 29 Cultural Elements in ISP and its Taxonomies

Current status: Liaison statements with SC22/WG15 were exchanged on this topic.

Discussion: New contributions:

N1080 SC22/WG15 Resolution on POSIX Profiles

N1081 Liaison statement to SC22/WG15 on POSIX Profiles

N1131 SC22/WG15 Liaison statement in Response to SGFS N1081

N1180 Liaison statement to SC22/WG15 on National Locale Issues

- Proposal: As SGFS does not considers National Profiles to form a special class, the issue should be closed.
- Issue 30 The relationship between OSI and OSE
  - Current status: this issue was open pending the discussions on the scope, methodology and terminology related to the expansion of the scope of TR 10000 from OSI to OSE.
  - Discussion: with the agreement reached in Cannes and the production of the latest drafts of TR 10000-1.3 (SGFS/N1178) and TR 10000-3 (SGFS/N1181) this issue can be considered to be resolved.

Proposal: Close the issue.

- Issue 31 The scope of OSE profiles
  - Current status: this issue was open pending the discussions on the scope, methodology and terminology related to the expansion of the scope of TR 10000 from OSI to OSE.
  - Discussion: with the agreement reached in Cannes and the production of the latest drafts of TR 10000-1.3 (SGFS/N1178) and TR 10000-3 (SGFS/N1181) this issue can be considered to be resolved.

Proposal: Close the issue.

Issue 32 Call for studies

- Current status: The French Member Body requested (in SGFS/N737) a study in the areas of Framework for User Requirements, Standard Info Base, Methodology for PAS, Framework for Technology Specifications, Framework for Technology Integration, attributes and methodology.
- Discussion: Some of the issues are under study in other groups (i.e., PAS in JTC 1), others have disappeared beyond the horizon (frameworks).

Proposal: Keep open, for discussion in New Orleans.

- Issue 33 Relationship of TR 10000 with ODP
  - Current status: this issue was open pending the discussions on the scope, methodology and terminology related to the expansion of the scope of TR 10000 from OSI to OSE.
  - Discussion: with the agreement reached in Cannes and the production of the latest drafts of TR 10000-1.3 (SGFS/N1178) and TR 10000-3 (SGFS/N1181) this issue can be considered to be resolved.

Proposal: Close the issue.

- Issue 34 Taxonomy, Profile Identifiers, and Profiles
  - Current status: this issue was open pending the discussions on the scope, methodology and terminology related to the expansion of the scope of TR 10000 from OSI to OSE.
  - Discussion: with the initial agreement reached in Cannes on the OSE taxonomy, and the production of the latest drafts of TR 10000-1.3 (SGFS/N1178) and TR 10000-3 (SGFS/N1181) the issue is resolved in principle. Minor additions can be handled as separate contributions to TR 10000-3.

Proposal: Close the issue.

- Issue 35 Expansion of the scope of TR 10000-3 to include system software portability
  - Current status: this issue was open pending the discussions on the scope, methodology and terminology related to the expansion of the scope of TR 10000 from OSI to OSE.
  - Discussion: with the agreement reached in Cannes and the production of the latest drafts of TR 10000-1.3 (SGFS/N1178) and TR 10000-3 (SGFS/N1181) this issue can be considered to be resolved.

Proposal: Close the issue.

Current status: This issue is in discussion in the RWSs and SC21.
