Subject : JTC1/SGFS like committees in other ISO or IEC TCs,
(ITTF meeting in Geneva June, 3 and 4 1991)

The French member body of JTC 1 believes that JTC 1's standards will be often involved in non JTC 1's profiles, it wishes to draw the attention of JTC 1 Secretariat on the followings :

- 1/ when a "profile" is based on the standards of a single TC, this profile is of the unique responsibility of that TC, and this situation does not require any specific organisation.
- 2/ if a profile refers to standards originated by more than one TC, it is crucial to avoid any problem of interpretation of these standards.

It is then necessary for the organisations intending to produce such profiles, to obtain a formal agreement of the concerned TCs, on the usage of the standards, and also on the way they are interpreted.

The notifications of these agreements must be delivered as mandatory information with the text of the profile, when the profile is submitted to the approval of ISO and/or IEC members.

That requires appropriate procedures and identified organisations, this is currently the role of the JTC 1/SGFS for profiles matching the taxonomy defined in ISO/IEC TR 10000-2, the procedure being defined in ISO/IEC TR 10000-1.
