JTC 1/SGFS has received the attached contribution from UNINFO and appreciates the interest to maintain alignment between TR 10000-2 and the European Memorandum M-IT-02.

SGFS believes that the taxonomy hierarchy in TR 10000-2 with AMH11, AMH12 and MHS13 follows by intention the hierarchy of transfer protocol modes P1, P3 and P7.

It should be noted that the taxonomy has been specifically redefined for the MHS-1988 family of standards.

The European profiles referenced (ENV 41218 and ENV 41219) are related to the MHS-1984 profiles. It is assumed that the allocation of A/MHnn profile identifiers to these ENV's in M-IT-02 is reflecting an outdated draft of the MHS taxonomy. The taxonomy included in TR 10000-2 reflects an harmonized input from the regional workshops.

SGFS forwards this statement together with the attachment to EWOS to ensure that it is taken into consideration when updating M-IT-02.
