

## ISO/IEC JTC1/SGFS/N1377

The ISO/IEC Special Group on Functional Standardization held a productive 12<sup>th</sup> Plenary meeting from June 17<sup>th</sup> till June 19<sup>th</sup> 1996 in Tokyo. 7 delegates from 5 National Bodies and 3 delegates from liaison organizations and ITU-T attended the meeting.

Management items addressed by the meeting:

### **SGFS Procedures**

A new version of the SGFS procedures incorporating the JTC1 guidelines for Referencing of PASs was produced. As the guidelines are only approved for a trial period, SGFS seeks the JTC 1 advise whether this interim version needs to be published.

### **Liaison on Inter-TC ISPs**

No issues are to be reported in this area.

### **Liaison Statements**

During the meeting, liaison statements to the JTC 1 SWG-CA (on interoperability) and JTC 1 SWG-GII (on the participation of SGFS and its S-Liaison organizations in the SWG-GII) were approved.

In response to document JTC 1 N3996 on the relationship between JTC 1 and the Regional Workshops a liaison statement to JTC 1 was approved (JTC 1 N4172) with the offer from the Regional Workshops to give a presentation on their activities (also in the light of their activities in the are of GII) to the JTC 1 Plenary meeting in Paris.

### **Progression of TR 10000**

A number of issues relating to TR 10000 were identified. Some of these issues have to do with the structure of TR 10000, some with the way in which TR 10000 should be maintained and published (WWW?). An SGFS Ad Hoc group was established to investigate these issues and to report back to SGFS by the next SGFS Plenary.
