- MISRA C:2012 Amendment 1
 - Adds 14 number new targetted Guidelines to cover gaps in coverage.
 - Mostly these are in areas of the *hosted* Standard Library that MISRA C has traditionally not considered.

 - No plans to directly incorporate CERT-C into MISRA C


MISRA C – Next Steps
