# 2022-11 Kona hybrid meeting information

## In-person participation

**Hotel.** Please [register using this link](#) by October 5, 2022; after that date the room rate can be booked if rooms are still available but availability is not guaranteed. You can also register in the **“WG 21 Conference”** room block by calling +1 800 367 2111 or +1 808 329 2911. Reservations can be cancelled without penalty up to 48 hours before arrival. The \$22 “destination amenity fee” is waived for our group and will be credited in your guest folio.

**Travel and transportation.** Kona is served by [Kona International Airport \(KOA\)](#). You can take a taxi to the hotel or [reserve a shuttle via SpeediShuttle](#). A car is not required for the meeting, but if you have one the hotel is a [20 minute drive](#) from the airport, and hotel parking is available for \$12 per night for guests in the WG 21 room block.

**Meals and refreshments.** Coffee and tea will be provided at the meeting for mid-morning and mid-afternoon breaks. Attendees are responsible for their own meals,

and you will find many dining options available within walking distance, including the hotel café and restaurant.

**Weather.** Kona weather is tropical and usually sunny, with occasional rain showers possible. Meeting rooms are air-conditioned, so consider bringing a light sweater.

★ **Welcome orientation.** We invite newer attendees to an informal orientation on **Sunday November 6 at 6pm** in the meeting hotel lobby or a nearby meeting room. This will cover information about the wiki and email lists, how subgroups work, and any questions you have about what to expect during the week.

**Other notes.** At the time of the meeting, U.S. and local authorities or the meeting hotel may require Covid-19 vaccination, masking, and/or other measures to travel to attend a meeting of our size.
