Resolutions of the second meeting of the ISO/TC97 Special Group on Functional Standardization, held on September 16-18, 1987 in London, England.

RESOLUTION 1 (APPROVED)

1. That the second sentence in the first bullet under section 3.1 of N1911 be edited to read as

This will include a review of the identified purpose for the ISP and identify liaisons required with committees responsible for the base standards called up in the ISP.

RESOLUTION 2 (APPROVED)

- 2. That TC97/SG-FS requests TC97 to ensure that in the allocation of responsibilities and authorities for the committee structure reporting to JTC1 that the successor to TC97/SG-FS be allocated at least the following powers.
 - a) Those rights and responsibilities as defined for a subcommittee (SC) in the ISO Directives.
 - b) The right to negotiate with the ISO/CS for a new form of publication for the taxonomy of International Standardized Profiles, to be published on a probable frequency of twice per year.

TC97/SG-FS requests the concurrence of TC97 on this request so that the work may proceed expeditiously and effectively.

Liaison membership enables other Technical Committees with immediate requirements for functional standards in the field of information technology to propose ISPs for inclusion in the current TC97/SG-FS work.
