STATUS: Editors' Instructions

The Editor of TR 10000-1 is instructed to amend the second WDTR 10000-1.3 (N687) using the Disposition of Comments document (N754).

The Editor of TR 10000-2 is instructed to commence development of a new edition (TR 10000-2.4) which, as well as incorporating further proposed contributions on OSI Taxonomy, will align with the emerging agreement on the place of OSI Profiles within the concept of OSE.

The Editor of TR 10000-3 is instructed to amend the first WDTR 10000-3 (N688) using the Disposition of Comments document (N759).

Any additional relevant material provided by NBs and LOs during the period while editing is taking place should be included in this process if possible, suitably identified as contributed text. Potential replacement text will be added with indication as an alternative.

This work will be done in parallel. The Editors will liaise on the transfer of material, and on the development of common terminology and resolution of boundary issues. In particular, the relative scopes of Parts 1, 2 and 3 concerning JTC1 and other technical committees, and the current limitation to the requirements of profiling OSE and OSI need to be clarified (see also N608 Rev, which has not yet been fully reflected in the current drafts).

The objective is to create new Working Drafts of Parts 1 and 3 by end of February 1993 which can be used as the basis for ongoing discussion in SGFS and among its members, especially in the meeting in July 1993. The timing of the draft of TR 10000-2.4 is dependent on the availability of contributions for new OSI profile taxonomy.
