WG2 COMMENTS ON DRAFT PASCAL BINDING FOR LIPC

- (1) Since ISO 7185 does not provide for separate compilation (although most Pascal implementations provide it as an extension), WG2 questions the utility of an LIPC-Pascal Binding, and whether provision of this Binding would be sufficient to resolve the UK NO-vote.
- (2) In 7.2 & 7.3, insert hyphens in "implementation-defined".
- (3) In 7.5, replace "integer-type" by "integer", and "real-type" by "real". It would probably be best to use bold or some other distinguished font for "integer", "real", "array of char".
