Abstract: A small rewording of a sentence is proposed.

Issue:

The first sentence of the definition of compatibility between types, at the start of Section 6.2.7, is:

Two types have *compatible type* if their types are the same.

This suggests in two different ways that types have a type, which is not the case.

Suggested change:

Replace the first sentence of 6.2.7 by:

Two types are *compatible* if they are the same.
