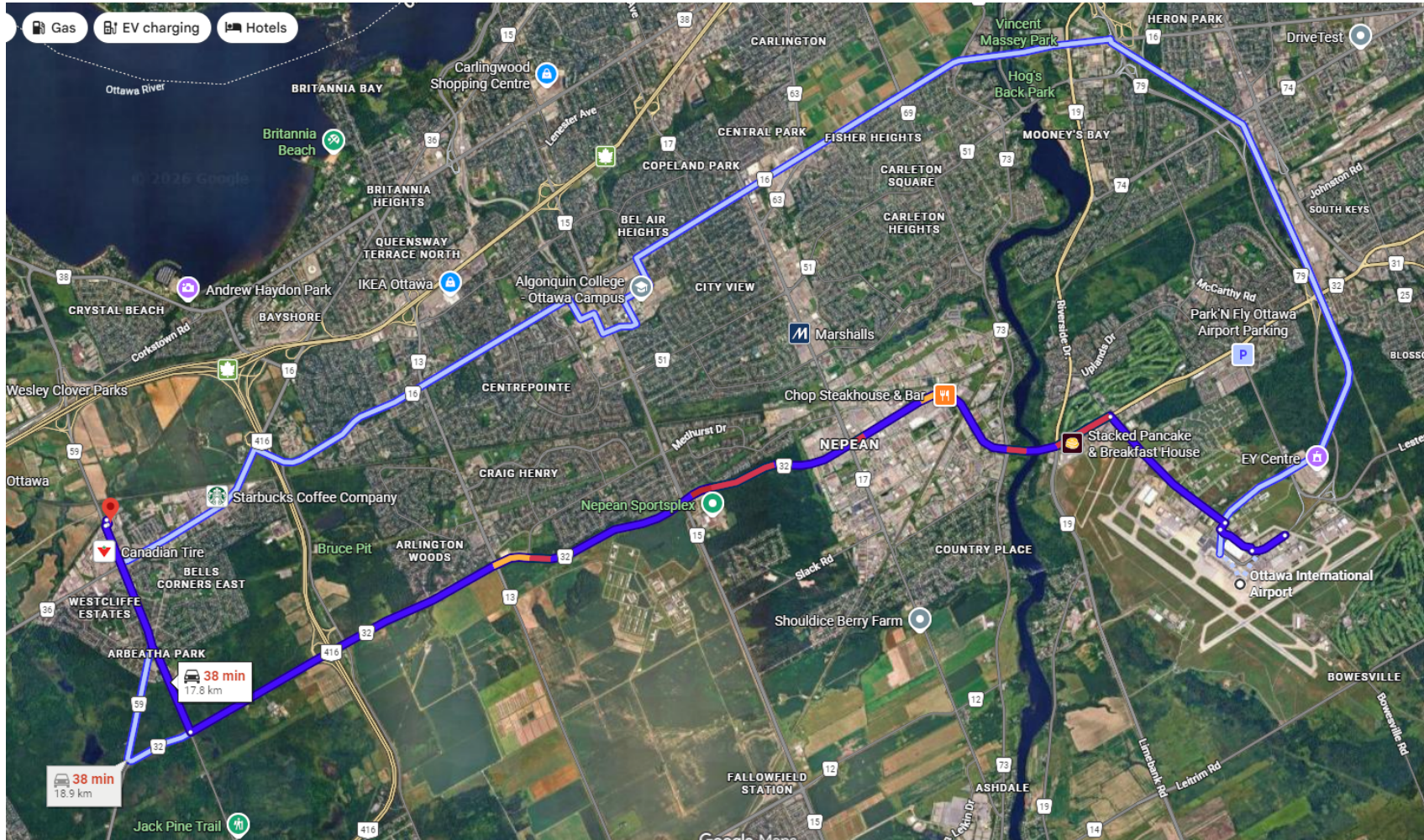

Entry to Canada

All visitors to Canada must hold a passport valid for a period of at least six months from the date of departure from Canada. In addition, visitors from some countries must obtain a visa prior to travel, and visitors from almost all other countries must obtain an electronic travel authorization (eTA). You can learn more about [electronic travel authorization](#) or [visa requirements](#) visiting the Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada website. Vaccinations may need to be required.

Please note that SCC is not responsible for issuing visas, and that a visa invitation letter is not a visa. If you need a visa invitation letter, please fill out a visa invitation letter request form (see Annex A) and send to isd-eni@scc.ca.

Airport

Ottawa is served by [Ottawa International Airport](#).

Delegates may take a taxi to get to the selected hotel. It will be a 25-30 minute drive depending on traffic.

Transportation

Public transportation in Ottawa is provided by the [OC Transpo](#) (buses).

Taxi service is provided by several companies in Ottawa. Major providers include:

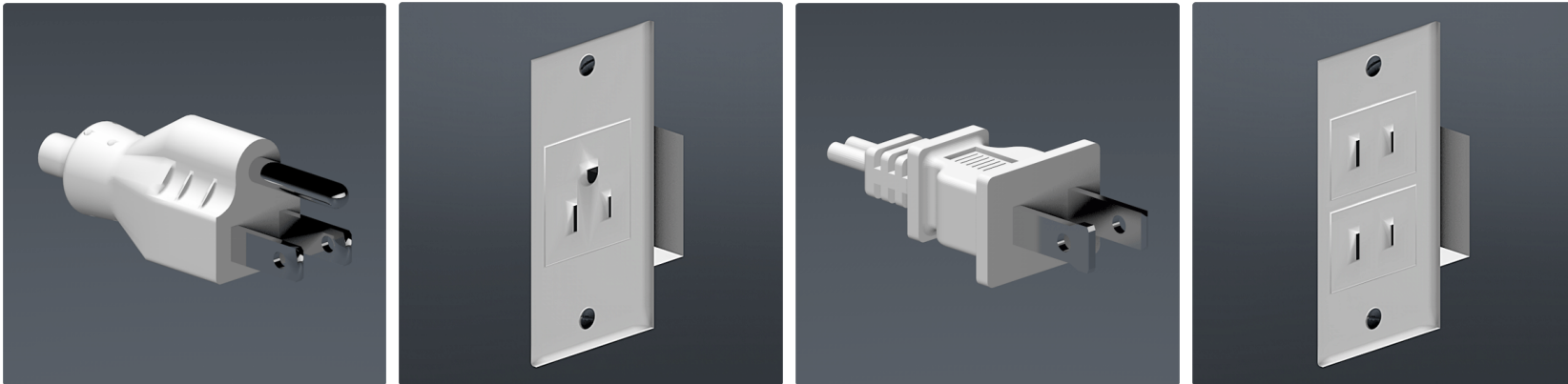

Ride-hailing services such as Uber are legally permitted to operate in Ottawa, including providing transportation to and from the airport.

Electricity

Standard electrical supply in Canada is 120 Volts at 60 Hertz. The [IEC plug types](#) in use are A and B. Hotels may have a limited number of transformers or converters; however delegates are encouraged to bring their own. Hotel rooms are usually supplied with hair dryers and irons.



Telecommunications

The international dialing prefix in Canada is +011. Calls made to numbers within Canada or the United States do not require an international dialing prefix, however long distance calls made to locations within Canada or the United States area must be prefixed by +1. Internet access may also be available in coffee shops, and at hotels. Hotels may charge access fees for internet access.

Language

The official languages of Canada are English and French.

Currency

The currency in Canada is the Canadian Dollar (\$, CAD), which is divided into 100 cents. Notes come in \$5, \$10, \$20, \$50, and \$100 denominations. Coins come in 5¢, 10¢, 25¢, 50¢, \$1, and \$2 denominations.

Credit and Debit Cards

Visa and MasterCard are the most widely accepted credit cards in Canada. Some retail establishments may also accept Discover or American Express cards. Debit cards using the Interac or NYCE networks may be used at most retail establishments. Please contact your card provider prior to travel to ensure that your card can be used in Canada.

Taxes

Most goods and services are subject to a 13% value added tax called HST or harmonized sales tax. HST is not included in advertised prices and is added at the register. There are additional taxes charged on alcohol, and room taxes on accommodation may also apply.

Tipping

Tipping is customary in sit-down restaurants (service charges are not automatically added to restaurant bills, except in the case of large groups). An average tip for satisfactory service is 15% to 20%. Hairdressers and taxi drivers are usually tipped at the same rate, while bellhops, doormen, porters and similar service providers at hotels, airports and stations are generally paid \$1 per item of luggage carried.

Emergencies and Insurance

The emergency number for paramedic, police, and fire services is 9-1-1. Attendees are encouraged to obtain travel, medical, personal, accident, and luggage insurance prior to departure. The Standards Council of Canada accepts no liability for any loss or injury incurred.
