## Resolutions of the ISO/IEC JTC 1/SWG on Registration Authorities (SWG-RA) 21 September 1992, New York City

 The JTC 1/SWG on Registration Authorities recommends to the JTC 1/SWG on Procedures that the text of Annex H of the Proposed Modifications to the JTC 1 Directives (JTC 1 N 1838) be modified to incorporate the text contained in JTC 1 N 2109. In addition, a note following section 1.4 should be added as follows:

Note: The application of these requirements to registration performed in ISPs is currently under review by SWG-RA and SGFS.

The SWG-RA further recommends that these modifications be incorporated into the Phase I revision of the JTC 1 Directives.

- The JTC 1/SWG on Registration Authorities authorizes submission of the liaison statement shown as JTC 1 N 2128 to the JTC 1 Special Group on Functional Standardization.
- The JTC 1/SWG on Registration Authorities instructs the JTC 1 Secretariat to maintain a current catalogue of published and proposed ISO/IEC JTC 1 standards requiring organizational Registration Authority assignments and brief descriptions of the items of registration.
- 4. The JTC 1/SWG on Registration Authorities requests ISO/IEC JTC 1 to invite "P" members to appoint a Registration Authorities Rapporteur for JTC 1 activities. JTC 1 National Body Registration Authority Rapporteurs are to serve as focal points within their National Bodies and to serve as a contact point for the SWG-RA.
- 5. The JTC 1/SWG on Registration Authorities requests its Secretariat to contact established JTC 1 Registration Authorities to elicit comments on items which might be of value for inclusion in a "Guidelines" document for Subcommittees preparing a standard containing requirements for registration.
  - Comments received will be distributed to the SWG-RA for review and preparation of the Guidelines document.
- 6. The JTC 1/SWG on Registration Authorities requests its Secretariat to initiate a call for National Body contributions regarding operation of the JTC 1/SWG-RA, taking into account the responsibilities contained within Annex H of the JTC 1 Directives. Only National Bodies represented at the September 21, 1992 meeting of the SWG-RA in New York City will be asked to submit contributions at this time. The Secretariat shall compile and re-circulate responses received; these comments shall be addressed at the next meeting of the SWG-RA.

- The JTC 1/SWG on Registration Authorities recommends to ISO/IEC JTC 1 approval of the assignment of Registration Authority responsibilities for ISO/IEC 10036 "Information Technology - Procedures for registration of glyph and glyph collection identifiers" to the Association for Font Information Interchange (AFII).
  - The SWG-RA requests the JTC 1 Secretariat to initiate a JTC 1 letter ballot on this proposed assignment as soon as possible.
- 8. The JTC 1/SWG on Registration Authorities reviewed the text of JTC 1 N 2055, "DIS Ballot Text for ISO/IEC 11576 'Information Technology Procedures for the Registration of Algorithms for the Lossless Compression of Data" and confirms that the registration procedures contained in this document meet the criteria as identified in Annex H of the JTC 1 Directives for publication as a procedure standard.
- In an effort to reduce undue expense related to international travel, the JTC 1/ SWG on Registration Authorities agrees to meet again within one year at a time and place convenient to the next meeting of the ISO/IEC JTC 1/Special Working Group on Procedures (SWG-P).
