Subj: Request for Guidance on Taxonomy Identifiers

The RWNMCC (joint meeting of AOW NMSIG, EWOS EGNM and OIW NMSIG) has developed an initial set of management function profiles designated "AOM2n" that have now reached DISP stage. In addition, the RWNMCC plans to develop further AOM2n profiles, possibly to exceed nine entries (AOM21n through AOM29n). It therefore seems advisable to consider the taxonomy identifiers proposed for AOM2n to ensure a consistent notation that allows for this case. One possible alternative is use of punctuation AOMa.b.c rather than AOMabc (where a, b, and c can be any number greater than zero). For example, AOM211 would become AOM2.1.1, distinct from some possible future entry AOM.2.11. DTR10000.2-3 seems tu make use of spaces for achieving the same goal (FVT 2 1 12 ), which is entirely appropriate but may be confusing in every day use of the identifiers. The RWNMCC seeks SGFS guidance on this issue.
