At its meeting in April 1993 the EWOS EG-OSE studied issues 30 and 31 of the SGFS Standing Document SD-7 (The SGFS Issues List) and offers the following comments:

Issue 30: The Relationship between OSI and OSE

OSI Profiles are a subset of OSE Profiles. OSI Profiles are part of the overall class of Interface Profiles (see EWOS contribution on TR10000, EWOS/EG-OSE/93/51).

Issue 31: The Scope of OSE Profiles

JTC1 activities on profiles are limited to standards within the scope of JTC1. However, as the concept of OSE Profiles is not limited to that scope, TR10000 should not restrict its application to JTC1 standards.

OSE Profiles can cover some (or all) internal interfaces and shall cover all interfaces external to the application platform. See also the proposals on the Building Block concept for section 5.2.3. of TR10000-3 in document EWOS/EG-OSE/93/51.
